

**ADVICE FOR CAUTION IN GIVING FURTHER
AGRICULTURAL CREDIT TO STATES**

*362. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAU-HAN: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Sir Malcom Darling, the Colombo Plan Consultant to the Planning Commission, after having inspected the cooperative movement in India, has advised Government to exercise caution in giving further agricultural credit to the States; and

(b) if so, what action Government have taken or propose to take on this recommendation?]

**QUANTITY OF PADDY, RICE AND WHEAT TO BE

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A. P. JAIN): Orissa Government are not likely to require any supply of rice and paddy from the Centre during the current year. The wheat requirements of the State will be met in full.

FARMERS' DELEGATIONS TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES

*377. SHRI S. PANIGRAHI: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether any farmers' delegations were sent to foreign countries in the year 1957;

(b) if so, the number of such delegations and the countries they visited during that year; and

(c) whether the tours undertaken by such delegations have resulted in any direct benefit towards food production?

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A. P. JAIN): (a) and (b). A group of 20 Farm Leaders was sent to the United States of America under the Indo-American Technical Assistance programme for a period of 3 months to study Community Organisations, the role of Farm Organisation, Cooperative work, in Extension, Rural Credit and related matters etc.

(c) It is considered that such visits of Farm Leaders to foreign countries assist in creating a band of enlightened workers who would help to develop farm organisations, rural cooperatives and thereby contribute to the development of agriculture in general.

**CONSTRUCTION OF DRY DOCK AT VISA-
KHAPATNAM**

*378. SHRI V. VENKATARAMANA: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the proposal to construct a Dry Dock at Visakhapatnam has been dropped; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor?
