(a) the number of election petitions filed against elections to Parliament and State Legislatures;

(b) the number of such petitions so far disposed of; and

(c) whether any petition relating to the first General Elections is still pending disposal; if not, the date on which the last petition was disposed of?]

(क) १९५७ के साधारण निर्वाचनों के पश्चात् संसद् के निर्वाचनों के खिलाफ ६० निर्वाचन याचिकाएँ और राज्य विधान

मंडलों के निर्वाचनों के खिलाफ ४१५ निर्वाचन याचिकाएँ निर्वाचन आयोग के सामने दायर की गई थीं ।

(ख) १६ निर्वाचन याचिकाएँ निर्वाचन आयोग द्वारा औपचारिक त्रुटियों के आधार पर रद्द कर दी गई, २ याचिकादाताओं द्वारा वापस ले ली गई और २५१ निर्वाचन अधि-करणों द्वारा निबटाई जा चुकी है ।

(ग) जी नहीं, अन्तिम याचिका पर फैसला २६ नवम्बर, १९५६ को हो गया था ।

†[THE MINISTER OF LAW (SHRI A. K. SEN): (a) Sixty election petitions against elections to Parliament and 415 election petitions against elections to State Legislatures were filed before the Election Commission after the General Elections of 1957.

(b) Sixteen election petitions were dismissed by the Election Commission for technical defects, 2 were withdrawn by the petitioners and 251 have been disposed of by the Election Tribunals.

(c) No; the last petition was disposed of on the 26th November, 1956.
