SHRI N. KANUNGO: Because it was regarding a specific item—the trade in green tea.

DEVELOPMENT OF SMALL SCALE INDUS-TRIES IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND N.E.S. BLOCKS FOR REHABILITATION OF DISPLACED PERSONS.

- *291. SHRI S. C. DEB: Will the REHABILITATION AND of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government propose to develop Small Scale Industries in Community Development Blocks and in National Extension Service Blocks where there is a large concentration of displaced persons; and
- (b) if so, what are the details of the proposal?

THE MINISTER OF REHABILITA-TION AND MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MEHR CHAND KHANNA): (a) Small Scale Industries as a means of providing gainful employment to displaced persons are normally encouraged in all areas with concentration of displaced persons. This is done irrespective of the fact whether these concentrations are in the Community Development Blocks and Nationa Extension Service Blocks or elsewhere.

(b) A statement is laid Table of the Sabha.

Financial assistance to set up small scale industries is given as follows:

- 1. In case of Pro- Entire investment on duction Centres to be set up by Govern-State ments Administrative Boards of Townships.
 - building, land, machinery and working capital is provided as loan. Expenditure training of displaced persons given as grant.
- 2. In case of schemes 75 per cent. of the individual overall investment enterpreneurs/ as loan, 25 per cent. Companies/Cobeing provided by operatives. the party.
