

(ii) In addition, the stock of each item of stores is verified once a year under the supervision of the Audit Officer/Board of officers of the area/unit concerned; and

(iii) Stock Verification Register is audited by the Local Audit Officer quarterly.

**ACCEPTANCE OF RUSSIAN CREDIT OFFER
FOR CERTAIN PROJECTS**

*440. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister of STEEL, MINES AND FUEL be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Russian offer of 500 million roubles of credit for machinery for certain projects made by Russia last year has been accepted; and

(b) if so, what has been done in furtherance of that agreement so far?

•THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND FUEL (SARDAR S. W. AN SINGH): (a) and (b). Yes; copies of the Agreement dated the 9th November, 1957 between the Government of India and the Government of the U.S.S.R. were placed in the Parliament Library on the 26th November 1957. Subsidiary contracts between the Indian Authorities and the Soviet Organisations concerned, for the preparation of the detailed Project Reports on the Projects covered by the Agreement, have been finalised.
