TAKING OVER OF THE PANNA DIAMOND MINES

- *64. SHRI AMOLAKH CHAND: Will the Minister of Steel, MINES AND Fuel be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have decided to take over the Panna Diamond Mines in Madhya Pradesh and propose to adopt mechanised exploitation of those mines; and
- (b) whther a corporation is proposed to be set up shortly to take up this work?

THE MINISTER OF MINES OIL (SHRI K. D. MALAVIYA): (a) and (b). Government is pursuing a suggestion to take over the Panna Diamond Mines in Madhya Pradesh. It is too early as yet to say what method of exploitation it will be necessary to adopt and whether a corporation or some other form of organisation will be the most suitable.

CENTRAL DRUG RESEARCH INSTITUTE, Lucknow

*74. SHRI V. VENKATARAMANA: Will the Minister of Education AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Drug Research Institute, Lucknow has not been recognised as an institute for advanced research work by some of the Indian universities;
- (b) if so, which are those universities; and
- (c) what are the reasons for such non-recognition?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (MAULANA ABUL KALAM AZAD): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c). Do not arise.

WALL STREET LOAN FOR TISCO

- *80. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Tata Iron and Steel Company has recently contracted a loan of 16 to 18 million dollars from Wall Street, New York for the expansion of their steel plant at Jamshedpur with the Government of India standing as a guarantee for the loan; and
- (b) if so, what are the terms of the contract?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT): The Government of India have agreed to stand guarantee for a further loan from the World Bank to Tata Iron and Steel Company for its expansion programme and it is probable that certain banks in the United States may participate in such a loan. The matter has however not yet been finalised.

Occurrence of Pyrites Crystals in Mahasu District

- *81. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister of Steel, Mines and Fuel be pleased to state:
- (a) whether crystals of pyrites have recently been found to occur in the

rocks near Matiana in Mahasu district on the Hindustan-Tibet Road; and

(b) whether a detailed survey of that area has been taken up to explore the zones of minable pyrite concentrations?

THE MINISTER OF MINES AND OIL (SHRI K. D. MALAVIYA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Samples collected from the area are under examination in the Geological Survey of India. If the results are found encouraging, detailed sampling will be undertaken by the Geological Survey of India in the next field season to assess the potentiality of the area.
