THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI HUMAYUN KABIR): With the permission of the Chairman I wish to correct the reply given by me to part (d) of Starred Question No. 192 on 29th May 1957 in the Rajya Sabha.

On the basis of information supplied by the Indian Airlines Corporation I had then stated that no expenditure was incurred on advertisement regarding the proposed discontinuance of air halt at Nagpur and its subsequent cancellation. In reply to a supplementary question I however said that I would make futher enquires in the matter.

I now find that the information then supplied by the Corporation was incorrect and an expenditure of Rs. 948 was incurred for advertisement in two Madras dailies.

I greatly regret that the information I gave to the House on the 29th May 1957 was not correct.
