

अमेरिकन तकनीकी सहायता कार्यक्रम के अधीन अपेक्षित बहुत सा सामान प्राप्त हो चुका है। वर्षा, पानी का बहाव इत्यादि के सम्बन्ध में बेसिक सर्वे डाटा (Basic Survey data) के इकट्ठे करने का काम अभी जारी है।

(ख) राज्य सरकार और केन्द्रीय सरकार का रूपों में व्यय का अनुमानिक हिस्सा क्रमशः १६.५० लाख रुपये और ८.५० लाख रुपये है। इसके अतिरिक्त, इस प्रायोजना के अधीन विदेशों से आयात किये हुए सामान पर होने वाले डालर व्यय के बराबर रूपों का ५० प्रतिशत राज्य सरकार देगी।

इस वक्त यह कहना मुमकिन नहीं है कि सिंचाई कितने क्षेत्र में की जा सकेगी, क्योंकि ये प्रायोजना के अधीन इकट्ठे किये जाने वाले सर्वे का डाटा पर निर्भर है।

THE MINISTER OF CO-OPERATION (DR. P. S. DESHMUKH): Presumably, reference is to the project for water resources survey and minor irrigation works undertaken by the Bombay Government. The present term of the project is up to 31st May 1958, but may have to be extended. The bulk of equipment required has been received under the American Technical Assistance Programme. Collection of basic survey data regarding rainfall, stream flow etc. is presently in progress.

(b) The estimated shares of Rupee expenditure between the State Government and the Central Government are Rs. 16.50 lakhs and Rs. 8.50 lakhs, respectively. In addition, the State Government will bear 50 per cent, of the rupee equivalent of the dollar expenditure on equipment imported from abroad under the project.

It is not possible at this stage to indicate the area likely to be irrigated as this is dependent upon the

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : कब तक आशा की जा सकती है कि सर्वे का परिणाम आ जायगा?

डा० पी० एस० देशमुख : इसकी मुदत तो ३१ मई, १९५८ तक है। स्टेट्स का रिआगेनाइजेशन हो जाने से तीन स्टेटों में जो हिस्से बिखरे हुए थे वे अब बम्बई राज्य में इकट्ठा हो गए हैं। इसलिये उस काम में कुछ देरी लग जायगी।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : कितना बड़ा क्षेत्र है जिसके ऊपर सर्वेक्षण किया जा रहा है?

डा० पी० एस० देशमुख : यह तो काफी बड़ा एरिया है।

CONSTRUCTION OF RAILWAY LINES BETWEEN BHAVNAGAR-TARAPUR AND JHUND AND JAMNAGAR

*569. SHRI M. B. JOSHI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the construction of the proposed new Bhavnagar-Tarapur broad gauge line is to be started during the Second Five Year Plan period;

(b) whether a contract for the earthwork of the said line has since been given; and

(c) whether the construction of the proposed new broad gauge line between Jhund and Jamnagar is also likely to be taken up during the Second Five Year Plan period?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) and (c). The proposals are not included in the 842 miles of new construction approved for the Second Five Year Plan by the Planning Commission.

(b) Does not arise.

(a) the number of Ministers who travelled in railway saloons during the years 1954-55, 1955-56 and 1956-57;

(b) the cost per mile of carrying a railway saloon;

(c) the cost of manufacture of a railway saloon; and

(d) the number of saloons manufactured after 1947?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) to (b). The information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

DR. SHRIMATI SEETA PARMANAND: This is such a simple question. At least will the hon. Minister kindly give information about (b), (c) and (d)? 'The cost per mile of carrying a railway saloon'—that information must have been there all the time. Even if it takes time for the first part of the question, may I kindly have replies to these—the cost of manufacture of a railway saloon; and the number of saloons manufactured after 1947?

SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM: These also cannot be given, because it is not maintained by the Railway Board. It is maintained by the different Railway Administrations and we have to get this information from the various Railway Administrations.

DR. SHRIMATI SEETA PARMANAND: May I know approximately by what time the information would be made available?

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: As soon as they become available.

SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM: As soon as they are available.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Next question.

SHRI B. K. MUKERJEE: The Minister's saloons ...

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I am going to the next question.

(a) the progress so far made in the survey carried on under the Indo-American Technical Assistance Programme regarding the means of irrigation available in those regions of Bombay State where rainfall is scanty, and the time by when the survey is expected to be completed; and

(b) the amount of money to be spent by the State and Central Governments on the survey and the area likely to be irrigated under this scheme?]

(क) शायद, यह संदर्भ बम्बई सरकार के पानी साधन के सर्वेक्षण और छोटी सिंचाई के काम की प्रयोजना के सम्बन्ध में है। इस प्रयोजना की वर्तमान अवधि ३१-५-५८ तक है लेकिन ये बढ़ाई जा सकती है।
