f] CONVERSION OF OSMANIA UNIVERSITY INTO HINDI UNIVERSITY

*588. SHRI P. N. RAJABHOJ: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH be pleased to state whether Government propose to convert the Osmania University into a Hindi University; and, if so, at what stage is the proposal now?]

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI) : There is no proposal to convert Osmania University into a Hindi University. However, the question of the reorganisation of the

Osmania University into a Central University with Hindi as the principal medium of instruction is being pursued with the State Government of Andhra Pradesh.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: May I know from the hon. Minister whether the Committee that was appointed to enquire into the possibility of having Hindi as the medium has submitted its report and if so, what are its findings?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Not yet.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: When is it likely to submit the report?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: We have requested the Chief Minister of Andhra to let us have the agreement of his Government to the proposal first and then the Committee will start.

DR. W. S. BARLINGAY: Is it not true that there was a proposal that this University should be directly under the management of the Government of India?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Yes, Sir. That was the proposal and that proposal has been before the Government since 1951.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: Is the hon. Min's'r aware that the former Hyderabad Government and the present Andhra Government have opposed the conversion of the Osmania University into Hindi medium?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Yes, Sir. The Government are fully aware.

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Dr. Nihar Ranjan Ray.

DR. NIHAR RANJAN RAY: Sir, When I asked these questions I did not know the answers. I know the answers of all the three question; that stand in my name by now. But if the House is interested they can be taken up.

SHRI V. K. DHAGE: Dr. Ray may know the answers but the House would like to know them.

DR. RAGHUBIR SINH: There can be no private communication in this respect.

BIRLA SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY MUSEUM, CALCUTTA

*589. DR. NIHAR RANJAN RAY: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH be pleased to state:

(a) whether any progress has been made in working out the details of Museum by the Sub-committee appointed by the Planning Committee of the Birla Science and Industry Museum, Calcutta;

(b) whether the Ministry have been able to secure the services of an expert through the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation to help in the establishment of the Museum; and

(c) how the Ministry propose to utilise the Rs. 20 lakhs that has been provided for the Museum in the Second Plan?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (DR. MONO MOHAN DAS): (a) Yes, Sir.

(c) The amount will be utilised for both capital and recurring expenditure on the Museum *e.g.*, essential additions and alterations in the building, fabrication and acquisition of models and exhibits and expenses on staff and maintenance.

SHRI V. S. SARWATE: Is it the policy of the Government of India to open only one museum or will they be having a number of museums throughout the country?

DR. MONO MOHAN DAS: Another museum of this type—science museum—is being built up at present in the National Physical Laboratory, Delhi. This museum is going to be built up in Calcutta because Mr. G. D. Birla donated 12 bighas of land with a big building worth Rs. 20 lakhs for this purpose.

SHRI V. S. SARWATE: My question is not answered. What is the policy of the Government? Do they want to encourage the establishment of museums throughout the country?

DR. MONO MOHAN DAS: We are proceeding slowly. I have said that one is being established in Delhi, a science museum, and another in Calcutta. If our funds permit and if private bodies co-operate with us with money and material, building etc., then we can establish similar museums in other parts of the country.
