t [EXPANSION AND MODERNISATION OF ORDNANCE FACTORIES

131. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAU-HAN: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state the main features of the scheme for the expansion and modernisation of Ordnance Factories and when it is likely to be implemented?]

प्रतिरक्षा उपमंत्री (श्री के० रघुरमैया): जंगी सामान के कार्यालयों के प्रसारण और आधुनिक-करण सम्बन्धी प्रश्नों पर इतने सम्बद्ध उत्पादन के तमाम पहलुओं में जहां तक हो सके आत्मनिर्भरता प्राप्त करने के लिए, स्वदेशीय उत्पादन को बढ़ाने के प्रश्नों समेत, प्रतिरक्षा मंत्री द्वारा एक उपरक्षा मंत्री के सभापतित्व में, नियुक्त की गई कमेटी विचार कर रही है। इस समय जंगी सामान के कार्यालयों में पुराने और घिसे हुए साज सामान और यन्त्रों में प्रावस्थित परिवर्तन के लिए एक योजना कार्यान्वित की जा रही है। दूसरी रूप कृतियां तभी प्रकाश में आयेगी, जब कमेटी ने अपनी सिफारिशें पेश कीं।

f[THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI K. RAGHURAMIAH): Questions relating to expansion and modernisation of Ordnance Factories together with allied questions of stepping up indigenous production with a view to attain self-sufficiency as far as possible in production in all its aspects are under active consideration by a committee appointed by the Defence Minister under the Chairmanship of one of the Deputy Defence Ministers. At present a plan for phased replacement of old and worn out plant and machinery in the Ordnance Factories is under implementation. Other features will be available as soon as the committee have made their recommendations.]
