BETTIAH CAMP DESERTERS

SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA (West Bengal): Sir, I have given notice for the discussion of a matter of public importance, namely, the recent state-

ment of the Minister for Rehabilitation which has resulted in the refusal of food and shelter to the displaced persons who have returned from the Bettiah Camp on account of intolerable conditions and police repression launched against them. I would request you and through you the Government to make it possible so that we can take up discussion on so vital a subject. I would like to have it taken up even before we take up the Presidential Address.

MR. CHAIRMAN: (*Turning towards the leader of the House*) It will be sent to you in due course, you will consider it and let us have your answer.
