T[EVACUATION OF FLOOD AFFECTED
VILLAGES IN DELHI]

*134. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAU-HAN:
Will the Minister for HOME AFFAIRS be
pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Delhi
Administration are evacuating some of the
villages near the river Jamuna which are
affected by floods, if so, what is the number
of such villages and the area of land attached
thereto;

(b) whether Government are making any
arrangements to rehabilitate the people of
these villages and also to provide them with
land;

(c) whether any compensation will be
paid to these villages; and

(d) if so, what will be the total
amount of compensation to be paid
to them?]

गृह-कार्य मंत्रालय के राज्य मंत्री (श्री
बी० एन० दातार): (क) बाढ़ों से प्रभावित

गांवों को दूसरे सुरक्षित स्थानों पर बसाने
अथवा उनकी सतह को ऊंचा करने की एक
योजना दिल्ली प्रशासन के विचाराधीन है।
ऐसे गांवों की संख्या १४ है, जिनका कुल
आबादी-क्षेत्र लगभग ११४ एकड़ है।

(ख) गांव की जिस आबादी को दूसरी
जगह बसाया जायेगा उसके लिए भूमि प्राप्त
करने का प्रस्ताव है।

(ग) चूंकि कई जगहों पर बसाये जाने
वाले ग्रामीणों का उनकी वर्तमान जमीनों पर
अधिकार रहेगा, इसलिए उन्हें कोई मुआवजा
देने का प्रश्न ही नहीं उठता।

(घ) प्रश्न नहीं उठता।

[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE
MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI B. N.
DATAR): (a) Delhi Administration have under
consideration a scheme designed either to
shift to alternative safe sites or to raise plinth
level of villages open to adverse river action.
The number of such villages is 14, having
aggregate *abadi* area of 114 acres
approximately.

(b) It is proposed to acquire land for
residential accommodation for the people in
cases in which village *abadis* are shifted to
new sites.

(c) As the villages shifting to new sites
will continue to own their existing lands, the
question of payment of any compensation to
them will not arise.

(d) Does not arise.]

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : इनको बसाने
के लिए जो जगहें तलाश की जा रही हैं, वे
कौन कौन सी जगहें हैं और क्या उन जगहों
का रिक्रिजिशन होना शुरू हो गया है ?

श्री बी० एन० दातार : हां, शुरू हो
गया है।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : वे जगहें क्या उनके खेतों, अर्थात् होल्डिंग्स, से नजदीक होंगी या दूर होंगी ?

श्री बी० एन० दातार : नजदीक कीये होंगी, दूर ही होंगी क्योंकि ऊंची सतह पर जगह दूर जाने पर ही मिल सकती है ।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : मेरा प्रश्न यह है कि उनके खेतों से जब बहुत दूर

श्री बी० एन० दातार : बहुत दूर नहीं ।

SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: May I know if any help will be given to them for building their houses?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: They will be given some loans for the purpose of constructing their houses.

SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: May I know what is the frequency of floods during the last five years in those particular areas?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: We had high floods in 1955 and 1956. Formerly in 1947.

SHRI H. V. TRIPATHI: What is the number of persons affected?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: The number is different in different villages. I have got the figures, but the list is long.

SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN: May I know if any subsidy is likely to be given to these people for building their houses?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: The whole question is under consideration and I imagine that they will be given loan assistance.

FORD FOUNDATION GRANTS TO INDIA

*135. SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: Will the Minister for FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) the form and extent of Ford Foundation grants made available to India during the current year; and

(b) the places where and the manner in which these grants are-being utilised?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR FINANCE (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT): (a) Four cash grants totalling \$ 2.37 million have been authorised so far from 1st January 1957.

(b) (1) For a centre at New Delhi for studies in foreign investment opportunities.

(2) for an international team and seminar on labour leader education at New Delhi,

(3) training of Indian engineers in, U.S. steel industry, and

(4) a scheme for strengthening role of village teachers in rural development areas.

SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: May I know whether this is an annual feature or this is spread over certain years?

SHRI B. R. BHAGAT: The Ford Foundation does not make annual allocations but they make it on the basis of individual projects.

SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: To what extent, Sir, is this expected to fill up the deficit financing of the Second Five Year Plan?

SHRI T. T. KRISHNAMACHARI: I do not think we can look at it from the point of view of filling up the deficiency in our plan. It does fill a need which arises from time to time for which Government are not either inclined to set apart funds or could not set apart funds. As a matter of fact one of these items is a thing with which Government has no concern at all. It is an important institution and Government have not been officially consulted about it, and we have no-objection and we do not have to criticise about it. The rest are schemes worked in conjunction with Government. For instance, the training of Indian personnel in steel industry in the U.S.A.—it is a scheme which has been sponsored by the Ministry of
