(b) if so, what are his recommendations in this regard?

THE MINISTER FOR FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A- P. JAIN): (a) Yes. The Secretary, Indian Central Arecanut Committee visited the Andaman Islands in February 1954.

(b) He reported that the Andaman Islands are eminently suited for the cultivation of arecanut and suggested that development of arecanut both in small holdings and large scale or estate holdings may be taken up.

CENTRES FOR LEPROSY CONTROL

CHANDRA-SEKHM*): Sir, in reply to a supplementary question in the Rajya Sabha on 5th September 1956. in connection with Starred Question No. 537, regarding leprosy, it was stated that 40 centres have been opened, out of which four were Treatment and Study Centres and 36 were Subsidiary Centres. At another place in reply to a supplementary it was stated where leprosy is more prevalent than in others, 14 .centres have been established. The

correct position, however, is that 34 centres have been established, out of which four are Treatment and Study Centres and 30 Subsidiary Centres.
