

SCHEME FOR INCREASING PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF RADIO SETS

133. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister for COMMERCE AND CONSUMER INDUSTRIES be pleased to state whether Government have any scheme under consideration for increasing the production capacity of radio sets in India; and if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER FOR COMMERCE AND CONSUMER INDUSTRIES AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI MORARJI DESAI): Yes, Sir. Two schemes for expansion of capacity of the existing units concerned, by 30,00 radio sets per annum are under consideration.

(b) Rs. 82 lakhs. approximately.

have seen press reports about Mr. Feroze Khan Noon's statement at a meeting at Rawalpindi on 21st October 1956 in which he is supposed to have said that there was only one country in the world inimical to Pakistan and that was Bharat. No official version of Mr. Noon's speech is available. Government have taken no action regarding this reported statement.
