SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: May I know the amount of money granted for one centre by the United Nations Organisations and the amount of money given by the States?

SHRIMATI M. CHANDRASEKHAR: I have not got the detailed information. The UNICEF provides special imported equipment and supplies for the centres and I have not got the information about the States.

SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: On what basis is this allotment of centres made to the various States and how is it that while the most backward States like Andamans and Manipur, where there are no other organisations working in this connection, have been given only one centre, the other very prosperous States like Bengal have been given 349 centres?

SHRIMATI M. CHANDRASEKHAR: Most of the States get according to the needs of the States.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: Population?

SHRIMATI M. CHANDRASEKHAR: Not population but because they ask for the necessary assistance, and that is given. It is not decided by us.

SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: May I know the number of WHO experts working in this connection in India?

RAJKUMARI AMRIT KAUR: I have not got figures for the number of experts that are here. Wherever possible we provide Indian experts also. I could find out for the hon. Member as to how many WHO experts happen to be here at the moment.

SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: Who is paying for their expenses and other emoluments?

SHRIMATI M. CHANDRASEKHAR: As usual the WHO experts are paid by WHO and only the travelling expenses inside India and boarding charges are paid by the Government of India.

SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: What is the amount spent on them by our Government?

RAJKUMARI AMRIT KAUR: This is an agreement between WHO, UNICEF and the State concerned. The pattern of assistance is that while the WHO provides regional and local experts advice and services of international personnel, the UNICEF provides imported supplies and equipment and drugs and diet supplements. The bulk of the financial burden and the greater part of the planning and execution of every project is met by the State Governments and the work is carried out by Indian medical personnel.

#### PUBLIC HEALTH SCHEME IN ASSAM

\* 155. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAUHAN: Will the Minister for Health be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to launch any public health scheme in Assam with the assistance of the World Health Organisation and the United Nations Children's Fund;

(b) if so, what are the details of the scheme and when it is expected to come into operation; and

(c) the expenditure to be incurred on the scheme and the contribution to be made thereto by each of the above mentioned organisations ?]

स्वास्थ्य उपमंत्री (श्रीमती एम० चन्द्रशेखर):

(क) जी, हां ।

(ख) व (ग). आसाम राज्य के ग्राम-स्वास्थ्य नसिंग, शिक्षा और मां व बाल-स्वास्थ्य के एक संयुक्त प्रोग्राम के बारे में एक प्लान सभा की मेज पर रख दिया गया है जिसमें सार्वजनिक स्वास्थ्य योजना का विस्तृत वर्णन और यूनिसेफ, विश्व स्वास्थ्य संगठन व सरकार द्वारा उस पर होने वाला खर्च दिखाया गया है [देखिये परिशिष्ट १४, अनुपत्र संख्या २१] योजना चालू वर्ष में काम करने लगेगी ।

T[THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR HEALTH (SHRIMATI M. CHANDRA-SEKHAR) :

(a) Yes.

(b) and (c). Details of the Scheme and the financial commitments of the UNICEF, WHO and the Government are given in the Plan of Operations for a combined Rural Health, Nursing Education and Maternal and Child Health Programme in the State of Assam, a copy of which is placed on the Table of the Sabha [See Appendix XIV, Annexure No. 21]. The scheme will come into operation during the current year.

राजकुमारी अमृत कौर : यहां मेरे पास आंकड़े तो नहीं हैं, लेकिन अक्सर ऐसा ही होता है कि ५० फीसदी हम देते हैं और ५० फीसदी वे देते हैं ।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : क्या यह समझा जाय कि तकरीबन ४२ लाख रु० वहां से मिले होंगे जब कि ४२ लाख रु० से ऊपर आपने खर्च किया होगा ?

राजकुमारी अमृत कौर : जी हां, मेरे खयाल में ऐसा ही होगा ।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : क्या ऐसी स्कीम कहीं और भी दूसरे राज्यों में चालू करने का विचार है या द्वितीय पंचवर्षीय योजना काल के बीच में चालू करने का विचार है ?

राजकुमारी अमृत कौर : जी हां, पंचवर्षीय योजना में जितने भी प्रान्त हैं, जो जो उन्होंने इस मामले में मांगा है वह उनको दे दिया गया है।

श्री नवाब सिंह चौहान : क्या आसाम ने ही इस स्कीम को मांगा था या अन्य प्रान्तों ने भी इस प्रकार की कोई स्कीम पेश की थी ?

राजकुमारी अमृत कौर : जी नहीं । ऐसी योजनायें तमाम प्रान्तों में चलती हैं।

SHRI P U R N A CHANDRA SHARMA: Will the hon. Minister kindly repeat the answer to part (b) of Question 155 ?

SHRIMATI M. CHANDRASEKHAR: In English?
