THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI OSCAR FERNANDES): (a) Water harvesting works are permissible under the MPLADS Scheme.

(b) and (c) Water harvesting including rain water harvesting will help in augmenting the surface water and raising the ground water level thereby enhancing the availability of water for use. As and when Member of Parliament recommends rain water harvesting works in a particular area, the district authority concerned examines and sanctions the same, if found feasible and permissible under the MPLADS Scheme.

### **Upgradation of Telephone Exchanges in Mizoram**

\*267. SHRI LALHMING LIANA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Telephone Exchanges with their capacity in the State of Mizoram and the exchanges which are earmarked for upgradation during the current financial year;

(b) whether BSNL is contemplating to cover the whole State of Mizoram with WLL during the financial year 2005-06; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI DAYANIDHI MARAN): (a) There are 69 Telephone Exchanges with the capacity of 71892 lines in the Mizoram State. The exchanges in Statement-I (See below) are earmarked for upgradation during the current financial year.

(b) and (c) BSNL is contemplating WLL coverage almost in the whole State of Mizoram during 2005-06. At present there are 7 Nos of BTSS, each of 500 lines capacity (Total 3500 lines) as per details given in the Statement-II (See below) and there is a plan of add 23 more BTSS with the total capacity of 17250 during the current financial year 2005-06 as per details mentioned in the Statement-III.

### **National Ship Design and Research Institute**

\*268. SHRI S.M. LALJAN BASHA: Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present role of the NSDRI in Visakhapatnam;
- (b) the funding provided by Government to the NSDRI over the last three years, year-wise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the work load and work output of NSDRI is totally inadequate;
- (d) whether Government propose to wind up the Institute;
- (e) if so, whether Government would hand over the NSDRI to Andhra University; and
- (f) if not, the reasons for funding of NSDRI?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI T.R. BAALU): (a) The National Ship Design and Research Centre (NSDRC) is primarily engaged in ship design and research activity.

(b) The Government has not provided budgetary support to NSDRC over the last three years for its day-to-day functioning. However, NSDRC has been given grant-in-aid of Rs. 5.00 lacs during 2002-2003 and Rs. 19.50 lacs during 2003-2004 for carrying out a study on Assessment of Demand Vs. Capacity of Shipbuilding and Standardisation of Ships.

(c) The output of NSDRC is sub-optimal.

(d) No, Sir.

(e) and (f) Do not arise.
