

SHRI B. N. DATAR: There is one training school for the I.A.S. and one Central Police Training College for the I.P.S.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: May I know, Sir, the strength in those training institutions?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: The strength this year in the I.A.S. Training School is 56 and the strength in the Central Police Training College is 32.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: With regard to the I.A.S., after passing their examinations, are they necessarily to be trained in Delhi? There is another school at Simla, is it not so, to give them training in audit and accounts?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: No, Sir, so far as the I.A.S. Training School is concerned, this is the final training school. Then they receive further training in the secretariats of the States where they are posted.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: After they pass in the I.A.S. examination, if their bent of mind was towards it, are they not sent to Simla for their training in auditing and accounting?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: I may point out to the hon. Member, Sir, that they are not sent there but our I.A.S. probationers are sent out to different part of India including Kashmir and Rajputana and perhaps Simla also.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: May I know, Sir, from the hon. Minister whether there is any examination at the end of this training and whether the marks obtained in that examination count towards seniority?

SHRI B. N. DATAR: Sir, there is the probationer's examination at the end of the year and then those marks naturally are taken into account.

#### ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCIENCE INSTITUTE

\*419. SHRI M. VALIULLA: Will the Minister for EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal to set up another institute of the type of the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore; and

(b) if so, where it will be established and at what cost?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR EDUCATION (DR. MONO MOHAN DAS): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: May I know whether there was not a scheme to expand the existing Institute in Bangalore and, if so, what has been done in that direction? If you are not starting another institution of that kind, at least there was a scheme to expand the existing Institute at Bangalore.

DR. MONO MOHAN DAS: Sir, an elaborate scheme for the expansion of this particular institution was taken up in 1946 involving an expenditure of Rs. 177 lakhs. That particular scheme has been completed, Sir, two or three years back.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: May I know, Sir, the number of students who were studying in that Institute at that time, that is, in 1946, and the number studying at present?

DR. MONO MOHAN DAS: At present the number is 400. At that time I do not know.

#### OIL EXPLORATION IN CAUVERY BASIN

\*420. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister for NATURAL RESOURCES AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH be pleased to state:

(a) whether the exploration of the Cauvery basin for finding oil resources is being conducted by Government;

(b) if so, what is the cost of the scheme;

(c) the number of technical personnel engaged on this work; and

(d) the quantity of oil estimated to be available there?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) No, Sir, but investigation in the area has been included in the programme for the last two years of the Second Five Year Plan period.

(b) An estimate has not been prepared.

(c) Does not arise.

(d) It is not possible to make an estimate at this stage.
