CONSTRUCTION OF A ZINC SMELTER

*443. SHRI JASWANT SINGH: Will the Minister for COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under consideration by Government for the construction of a zinc smelter in India; and

(b) if so, where it will be situated?

THE MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. M. SHAH):

(a) There is no concrete proposal as such before Government. In fact the quantity of zinc ore mined at present is approximately 250 tons a day and it is not sufficient for setting up a zinc smelter in India. It has been estimated that approximately a thousand tons of ore a day would be necessary in order to set up a zinc smelter on an economic basis.

(b) Dose not arise.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: May I know, Sir, where the present production of zinc is sent for smelting purposes?

SHRI M. M. SHAH: Only lead is sent to Bihar for smelting purposes.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: May I know, Sir, whether it is smelted in India?

SHRI M. M. SHAH: Zinc is not smelted in India. The quantity of zinc ore mined at present is about 250 tons per day. There is no smelting plant here.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: Is it not true that zinc is actually sent abroad for smelting purposes?

SHRI M. M. SHAH: That is true. We are exporting it to foreign countries.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: I want to know whether it is being sent abroad or not.

SHRI M. M. SHAH: It is being exported to some extent. But the intention is to set up a smelting plant in India, so that we may be able to manufacture at least one-third of the country's requirements.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: May I know, Sir, the places where zinc ore is mined?

SHRI M. M. SHAH: In Rajasthan, there are five places where it is mined. They are Zawar, Balria, Mochia Magra, Sunaria and Harn Mogra.

SHRI JASWANT SINGH: Is there any proposal in the Second Five Year Plan for establishing a smelting plant?

SHRI M. M. SHAH: For the present, Sir, the mining capacity is 250 tons. The attempt of the Government is to raise it to 1,000 tons. And I am glad to inform the House that we hope to succeed in that respect very soon. If that is done, it will be possible to put up a smelting plant in the country.
