SHRI M. VALIULLA: Not many?

SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON: I said 'not many incidents'.

SHRI B. K. MUKERJEE: How are these protests made? We have no connection with Portugal.

SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON: Through the Egyptian representative who is acting for us in Goa.
