THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR
RAILWAYS AND TRANSPORT (SHRI O. V.
ALAGESAN) : Information about these
damages is not compiled Statewise but
Railway-wise. The amount of damages caused
on the South-Eastern, Central and Western
Railways, which serve the States of Orissa
and Bombay among others, is approximately
Rs. 54,32,900.

RAILWAY PORTERS

194. SHRI M. VALIULLA: Will the
Minister for RAILWAYS be pleased to
state the amount collected from rail
way porters in the year 1955 as
licence fee?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR
RAILWAYS AND TRANSPORT (SHRI O. V.
ALAGESAN): Rs. 4,57,000 approximately.

This amount represents the licence fee
realised by the Railways from the porters
licensed direct by the Administrations, as
distinct from the fees paid by the porters to
contractors, at stations where they are
licensed through contractors and not direct.
