Promotion of battery driven bus

†2304. SHRIAJAY MAROO: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to the newsitem where it has been stated that IIT Delhi invented a battery driven bus;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to permit the commercial use of this bus; and

(C) what is the view of the Ministry regarding this bus?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) As informed by IIT, Delhi, further steps like assembling prototypes are required to be undertaken before the existing technology can be commercialized for different applications and capacities. Therefore, it would be premature for Government to take a view in the matter.

Review of Blocks under NELP-V

2305. SHRI CHITTABRATA MAJUMDAR: Will the Minister of . PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether a review has been sought on entire evaluation process of two blocks i.e. Block D-3 and Block-6 in KG under NELP-V;

(b) if so, whether a review is being done; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR): (a) to (c) No, Sir. Block D-3 (KG-DWN-2003/1) falling in KG deepwater & Block 6 (GV-ONN-2003/1) falling in the Ganga Valley basin under the Fifth Round of the New Exploration Licensing Policy (NELP-V) have already been awarded separately to two consortia. Block D-3 (KG-DWN-2003/1) has been awarded to a
