Completion of incomplete dams

2346. SHRI E.M. SUDARSANA NATCHIAPPAN: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps so far taken by Government for early completion of incomplete dams; and
 - (b) the time schedule fixed to complete these dams in the country?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV): (a) and (b) Irrigation being a State subject the irrigation projects are planned, formulated, funded and executed by the State Governments out of their own resources as per their priorities. Central assistance is released in the form of block loans and grants not tied to any sector of development or project. As on 01.4.2004, there were 169 major and 219 medium ongoing irrigation projects which have spilled over from Ninth Five Year Plan. Concerned with the delay in completion of the irrigation projects mainly due to the resource crunch being faced by the states, the Central Government commenced the Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) in 1996-97 to provide Central Loan Assistance (CLA) to such major/medium ongoing irrigation projects which are in on advanced stage of construction or beyond the resources capability of the States. Under the programme CLA/grant of Rs. 17,120.820 crore has been provided upto March, 2005 for completion of major and medium irrigation projects. As per the guidelines of AIBP the major/medium irrigation projects receiving CLA and AIBP are to be completed in four financial years. In the case of projects not covered under AIBP, the schedule of completion depends upon the allocation made by the states and removing other bottlenecks in progress of the projects.
