The candidates should be graduates in Chemical Engineering or Diploma-holders in Chemical Engineering or Mechanical Engineering.

They should be sponsored by their institutions for the training under the Government of India Scheme of Practical Training.

## POST-WAR RECONSTRUCTION FUND

301. SHRI VIJAY SINGH: Will the Minister for DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) the total amount of Post-War Reconstruction Fund at present lying with the different States; and

(b) how this amount is utilized?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR DEFENCE (SARDAR S. S. MAJITHIA) : (a) Rs. 5,31,82,396-7-1 as on 31st July 1955.

(K) The Post War Reconstruction Fund is utilized for schemes like Cooperative Land Colonies, Transport Societies, Maternity Centres, Vocational/technical training etc. Assistance in the form of grants and loans is also given to individual ex-servicemen on the merits of each case.

Loans which are interest free are given for small scale enterprises to enable ex-servicemen to earn their livelihood.
