THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (Maulana Abul Kalam Azad): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The National Centre for the Deaf is expected to consist of the following:—
 - (1) A Model School for Deaf children with a Clinic for the ascertainment of deafness and a Centre for Research into Phonetics attached to it; its capacity will be 200.
 - (2) A Technical Training Centre for the Adult Deaf; its capacity will be 100.
