(h) This will depend upon state of demand and the rate of production of the Indian firms in the Production during next few years the current year is estimated at 5,50,000 numbers, while imports will be of the order of 1,00,000 numbers and we are thinking in terms of a target for the end of the second Plan of 1 25 millions per year. . .
