they have stated this that the total cost of this force as also of another force which was maintained there should be borne by the Government. Government considered this request and in some cases Government have given actual grant by way of contributions and in some cases Government are going to waive the cost that they have recovered.

YOUTH CAMPS

-266. Shri D. NAR'AYAN: Will the lister for EDTJCATIO>I be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of youth camps organised by (i) Bharat Sevak Samaj and (ii) Government, during the last summer vacation; and
- (b) the amount of help given by Government to Bharat Sevak Samaj for i his purpose?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR EDUCATION (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): (a* Up to 30th June 1955 (i) 401 np; were sanctioned in favour of Bharat Sevak Samaj, and (ii) 143 camps through State Governments.

(b) Rs. 16,02,397.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: May I know on what basis these grants were cal-fulated?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Regarding the payment of grants, the usual rates: 4-0 for food per head per day and 0/8/0 for incidentals per head per day and actual transport charges.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: May I know if it is a fact that the grants gi«en to the Bharat Sevak Samaj were calculated on the basis of Rs. 1/10/- per boy whereas it was Rs. 2 per boy in the Government camps?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Two annas mr retained by the Bharat Sevak 9amaj for administrative purposes.

That is why probably there is a difference.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: Six annas more were paid to the Government camp boys.

to Questions

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: As far as my knowledge goes—it is subject to correction—there is no discrimination with regard to Government camps and the camps organized by other voluntary organisations.

PROF. G. RANGA: In view of the popularity of these camps and the good reports that we generally have had of their work, have Government considered the possibility of publishing reports of the work of the camps organized both under the auspices of the Bharat Sevak Samaj and also-by the A.C.C. and the N.C.C.?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: We shall certainly consider that suggestion.

श्रीमती सावित्री दंशी निगम: क्या सरकार को सह विदित्त हैं कि जितना रूपया इन कॅम्पाँ पर सर्व हुआ हैं लगभग उसके आधे मूल्य का निर्माण कार्य इन कॅम्पर्स ने सड़कों और बांधाँ की मरम्मत के रूप में किया हैं?

हा० कं० एस० श्रीमासी: जी हां. काफी निर्माण का कार्य हुआ हैं लेकिन में यह निवेदन करना चाहता हूं कि इनका मुख्य उद्दंश्य निर्माण करने का नहीं हैं बल्कि हमार नाजवानों को ठीक रास्ते पर लगाने का हैं।

SHRI AKBAR ALI KHAN: In view oi ihe fact that last year the amount was paid rather late and was not paid for all these students' camps, will Government see that I year more amount is provided and that it is paid at the right time?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Well, in the first place. I am not sure whether the amounts were paid late last yearv for as far as I know about these camps, we have been very particular to make the payments in

time. And this is evident from the very fact thai, a large number of *camps* have been held all over the rnuntry. There may bave been one or two instancfes where payment was made rather late, but normally we see that the payment is made *in* time.

BEGAM AIZAZ RASUL: May I know, Sir, out of this number of 401 camps organised by the Bharat Sevak Samaj, how many camps were for girls in the different States?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: I am afraid I cannot give the break-up just now.

Smsr N. D. M. PRASAD ARAO: How is the selection of these youths who go to these camps made?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Most of these are college students and the selection is left to the voluntary organisations or the organisations that sponsor the camps.

SHRr D. NARAYAN: Are thera any organisations other than the Bharat Sevak Samaj which came forward to organise these camps?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The two most important organisations which have participated in the work are the N.C.C. and the Bharat Sevak Samaj. There are other organisations also, such as the Scouts Associations and the State Governments also are organising these camps.

श्री कन्हें बालाल दाँठ बँदा: क्या मंत्री महोदय बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि एनठ सीठ सीठ और एठ सीठ सीठ के कैंम्पों और भारत सेवक समाज के केंम्पों में खाने की व्यवस्था किस प्रकार हैं?

हा० के० एल० श्रीमाली: में सदस्य महोदय से निवंदन करूंगा कि वह कुछ कॅम्प्स आकर दंखें और स्वयं दंख लें कि कॅसी व्यवस्था हैं।

थी कन्हें यालाल दाँ० बंदा: में स्वयं केंम्पों में गया हूं और मेंने दंखा हैं कि भारत संवक समाज में खाने की जो प्राइवेट व्यवस्था हैं उसमें ऑर एन० सी० सी० के कॅम्पों में जो व्यवस्था रहती हैं उसमें बहुत अन्तर रहता हैं ऑर बहुत अव्यवस्था रहती हैं। इसीलए मैं मंत्री महोदय से जानना चाहता हूं कि क्या इस सम्बन्ध में सरकार की कोई नीति हैं कि सरकार का पैसा इस तरह से व्यर्थ में सर्च न हो?

Mr. CHAIRMAN: No. speech.

डा० के० एस० श्रीमाली: यदि किसी केंम्प में भोजन की अव्यवस्था हुई हैं और सदस्य महोदय मेग ध्यान उस तरफ आकर्षित करेंगे तो हम इसकी प्री जांच कराएंगे और दंखेंगे कि इस प्रकार की अव्यवस्था न हो।
