total replenishable Annual Ground Water Resources of the country is assessed as 433 Billion Cubic Metres (BCM) and the Net Annual Ground Water Availability is assessed as 399 BCM. Existing Gross Ground Water Draft as on March, 2004 for all uses is 231 BCM per year. The Stage of Ground Water Development is 58%.

(c) and (d) Yes, Sir. Currently available information is always used for regulatory intervention, making choices of conservation schemes like artificial recharge, rain water harvesting, etc., to study and promote conjunctive use etc., to ensure sustainability in the use of ground water.
