EXPORT OF MONKEYS

*268. DR. RAGHUBIR SINH
BEHALF OF SHRIMATI VIOLET ALVA):
"Will the Minister for COMMERCE AND
INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether monkeys have been exported, subsequent to the Government of India's ban of March 11, 1955; if so, how many;

(b) whether the export was allowed by land, sea or air, in each case; and

(c) whether Government propose to revise their policy regarding export of monkeys?

THE MINISTER FOR COMMERCE (SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR): (a) and (b). With effect from 11th March 1955 each shipment is required to be specifically authorised by the Central Government. Export of 73,017 monkeys by air has been permitted from 11th March up to-date.

(c) No, Sir.

DIWAN CHAMAN LALL: May I ask whether any rules have been laid down for better transport arrangements for these monkeys which are exported?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: Yes Sir. It has been decided to allow export of monkeys subject to the following conditions:

(a) Monkeys will be used exclusively for the purpose of medical research and production of vaccine;

(b) The monkeys will be carried only by air and the carrier will guarantee humane treatment in transit;

(c) The monkeys will be examined by a qualified veterinary surgeon before export;

(d) Acceptable undertakings will be given by importers and exporters for the observance of the above conditions.

COST OF OFFICERS' QUARTERS AT SINDRI

*269. SHRI J. V. K. VALLABHA-RAO:
Will the Minister for PRODUCTION be pleased to state:

(a) the number of officers' quarters built in Sindri and the cost of each type of quarters; and

(b) the average maintenance charges for each type of such quarters?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR PRODUCTION (SHRI SATISH CHANDRA): (a) The total number of quarters is 57. A statement showing the number and cost of each type of quarters is placed on the Table of the House.

(b) The average annual repair and maintenance charges amount to 1 per cent, of the cost of the building concerned.
