DEMARCATON OF INDO-PAKISTAN BORDER

*346. SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) the length of undemarcated border between India and Pakistan; and

(b) the steps taken to expedite the work of demarcation?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI ANIL K. CHANDA): (a) The length of the entire border between India and Pakistan (excluding Jammu and Kashmir) is 3,966 miles. Out of a total of 2,463 miles in the Eastern Zone, 1,542 miles remain undemarcated and out of a total of 1,503 miles in the Western Zone, 1,499 miles remain undemarcated.

(b) In pursuance of the Indo-Pakistan Agreement of December, 1948, the Directors of Land Records of West Bengal, Assam, Tripura and Bihar on the Indian side and the Director of Land Records of East Bengal on the Pakistan side have been engaged in the work of demarcation of the Indo-Pakistan border in the Eastern Zone. They have since jointly demarcated about 921 miles. The work of demarcation on the remaining 1,542 miles is in various stages of preliminary operations and is being continued.

The question of demarcation of the Indo-Pakistan border in the Western Zone has been under discussion between the two Governments and was last discussed at a meeting held between the Minister for Home Affairs and the Pakistan Minister for the Interior in May 1955 and inspected. It was agreed that the entire boundary should be demarcated as early as possible and that the highest priority should be given to the demarcation of the land portion of the Punjab (I)—Punjab (P) boundary. The work of demarcation will be taken in hand as soon as the Government of Pakistan have ratified the agreement reached between the two Ministers.

SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: May I know, Sir, if the demarcation work is now going on?

SHRI ANIL K. CHANDA: Demarcation work in the Eastern Zone is going on.

SHRI M GOVINDA REDDY May I know, Sir, if the land border between East Pakistan and West Bengal is demarcated as distinguished from riverine border?

SHRI ANIL K CHANDA: Naturally, we are taking up the land boundary first and I have indicated in my answer that out of 2,463 miles, 1,542 miles yet remain undemarcated. We have done about 900 miles.

(a) whether a regional news bulletin in Kannada has been introduced in the All India Radio News Services; and if so, since when, and

THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY TO THE MINISTER FOR INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI G RAJAGOPALAN): (a) and (b) It is proposed to broadcast regional news bulletins in all the main languages of the country. The question of broadcasting a Kannada regional news bulletin will be taken up after the installation of 50 K.W. M.W transmitter at Bangalore

डा० बी० बी० कंसकर : उर्दू में बुलेटिन उन सबों से निकाली जा सकती हैं और वहां के लिये सोचा जा सकता है जहां कि ज्यादातर लोग उर्दू बोलते हैं। इस तरह की बुलेटिन काश्मीर से निकल रही हैं और हैदराबाद से भी निकल रही हैं।

†[**مولانا ام० فاروقی :** क्या आनर्बिल मिनिस्टर यह ख्याल फरमाते हैं कि लखनऊ में हैदराबाद से कम उर्दू बोलने वाले हैं ?]

डा० बी० बी० कंसकर : हैदराबाद में उर्दू बहुत सालों तक स्टैंड लैंग्वेज रही है और वहां काफी लोग उर्दू को समझते हैं और उसके जादी हैं। इसलिये पहले से जो चीज जारी थी वह चीज जारी रखी गई है।

SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA: May I know, Sir, how normally these regional news bulletins are prepared, whether news from the various localities is collected to be broadcast in these bulletins?

DR B V. KESKAR Regional news bulletins, as I said, are not yet completely established in all the regional centres. Wherever it has been established we have got our own unit which gets news mainly from news agencies but at present we are perfecting an organization for getting regional news through local correspondents also
