श्री लाल बहादुर: जी हां, प्रादिशिक सरकार का इस और ध्यान दिलाया गया हैं लेकिन अभी तक उनकी तरफ से कोई संतोषजनक पत्र नहीं मिला हैं।

## FORESTRY COMMISSION

- \*378. SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: Will the Minister for FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Government propose to set up a Forestry Commission; and
- (b) if so, what are the particulars relating to the proposed Commission?

THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE (Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH): (a) Yes, Sir,

- (b) The set up of the proposed Forestry Commission has not yet been settled but as and when it is established it will discharge the following functions:—
  - (i) the technical scrutiny of major working plans and of deviations from their prescriptions;
  - (ii) the collection, standardisation and timely publication of forestry statistics and intelligence;
  - (iii) carrying out market studies; and
  - (iv) the pooling and dissemination of technical information derived from States and foreign countries. It will also organise extension work for popularising forestry.

SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: May I know whethe this Commission is going to be a permanent body or an ad *hoc* body?

- Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: I expect, Sir, that when it really comes into being, it should be a permanent body.
- SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: May I know what is the likely composition of this body?
- DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: I have not got any details. It is very vague at the present moment and it will take some time before it is finalised.
- SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY; May I at least know whether there will be States' representatives on this body?
- Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: I am unable to say anything now.
- SHRI H. P. SAKSENA: Has Government prepared any blue-print of the proposed Forestry Commission?
- DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: No, Sir. Not beyond what I have stated. Beyond the functions we have not got much of a fixed idea.
- SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: Will the Government consider having States' representatives on this body?
- DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: I am not able to give an assurance.
- MR. CHAIRMAN: No, no. It is a suggestion for action.

## RETIRING ROOMS AND RESTAURANT CARS FOR ALL PASSENGERS ON THE RAILWAY

\*379. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Ministry for RAILWAYS be pleased to state whether necessary arrangements have since been made in ' all the zones to make the retiring rooms and restaurant cars available to all classes of passengers?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR RAIL-WAYS AND TRANSPORT (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): Yes. Sir.
