SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: Will he please lay them on the Table, Sir?

May I know whether there are any other departments under the consideration of the Unit?

SHRI M. C. SHAH: As I said earlier, the Unit had completed investigation and submitted reports in respect of 6 Ministries and 101 Attached Offices; the Unit has also completed detailed examination of four more Ministries and seven other offices. Out of the nineteen Ministries, nearly nine are vet to be examined.

PROF. G. RANGA: What were the results of this reorganisation either in the matter of economy or in the matter of efficiency?

SHRI M. C. SHAH: The question of the staff was kroked into by the Reorganisation Unit. Whenever it found any staff surplus it recommended abolition of such posts consistent with efficiency. Usually the Ministries discussed the recommendations with the Unit and later accepted certain of them.
