

**ANTI-LOCUST OPERATIONS**

•55. SHRI M. VALIULLA: Will the Minister for FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a meeting of the Expert Locust Committee was held in the month of April to consider the question of intensifying anti-locust operations in Rajasthan, Patiala and East Punjab States Union, Kutch and Saurashtra; and

(b) what steps Government have since taken in each of these States in that direction?

THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE (DR. P. S. DESHMUKH): (a) and (b). A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

**STATEMENT**

A meeting of the Expert Committee on locusts was held on the 8th April 1955 in New Delhi to review the progress of work done during the previous year and to consider the measures and preparations to be undertaken in the current year by the Anti-Locust Organisation for intensifying the Anti-Locust operations in the scheduled desert areas of Rajasthan, PEPSU, Kutch and Saurashtra as also in all the States which are vulnerable to locust attack. Locust control in this area is undertaken directly by the Central Anti-Locust Organisation but locust control in other areas which we call cultivated areas for convenience of reference is the responsibility of the State Governments concerned.

2. The Government of India have taken the following steps to implement the recommendations of the Expert Committee:

- (i) The Central Anti-Locust Organisation is strengthened by the provision of more staff—two Gazetted and 15 non-Gazetted, three more trucks, 750 power and hand spraying dusting machines, and 100 tons insecticides, etc. Insecticides, and other equipment were stocked at about 90 outposts all over the

desert areas of Rajasthan and other States:

(ii) The Government of India are maintaining a close contact with the Government of Iran, Afghanistan and Pakistan as also with the FAO in the matter;

(iii) The Research Unit consisting of adequate scientific personnel has been started for this purpose;

(iv) The Government of India is considering a proposal for establishment of aerial Plant Protection Unit.

3. In this Conference the need for adequate preparation for locust control in different States was also examined and the attention of the State representatives was drawn to the conditions and requirements in their respective States.

4. Government of India have not only been advising the concerned States about the Anti-Locust operations but have also materially assisted several of them in conducting campaign against locusts whenever the need for such assistance has arisen.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: In paragraph 2 (iv) of the statement, it is said that the Government of India is considering a proposal for the establishment of aerial Plant Protection Unit. May I know what steps have been taken in that direction?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: We are trying to find out suitable aerial equipment and aeroplanes. It will take some time. We cannot go very fast. I am glad to inform the House that the locust invasion has also diminished considerably and so, there is no such urgency.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: May I know the amount set apart for this purpose in 1954-55 and 1955-56?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: I have not got the information here. I would like to have notice.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: In paragraph 4, it is stated that the Government

have also materially assisted several States in successfully conducting the campaign against the locusts whenever the need for such assistance arose. May I know how many rupees worth of assistance has been given to the States?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: I have not got the value of the assistance given in rupees but I know, whenever we received any intimation from any State Government, we have given them very adequate help in the shape of sending the planes that we may have.

SHRI M. VALIULLA: It is stated that we are having the assistance of foreign governments for this purpose. May I know whether they also share the expenditure incurred in this behalf?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: Excepting the T.C.A. which sometimes assists us by giving some technicians and insecticide, etc., no foreign Government is assisting us. It is more international co-ordination that is intended.

[THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR) : The observations on the Solar Eclipse of the 20th June 1955 made in Ceylon by the Indian scientists are being studied and it will take some time to analyse fully the observational data collected. A copy of the publication containing the results of the analysis will be laid on the Table of the Rajya Sabha, as soon as it is ready.]
