### REPRESENTATION FROM TALCHER COA-I-FIELD WORKERS' UNION

\*515. SHRI S. N. DWIVEDY: Will the Minister for LABOUR be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received any representation from

Talcher Coalfield Workers' Union regarding violation of Labour laws by Talcher Coalfields Limited; and

(bi if so, what steps have been taken on the representation?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR LABOUR (SHRI ABID ALI) : (a) Yes; the Union has complained of the violation of the Industrial Disputes Act 1947, the Mines Act, 1952 and the Coal Mines Bonus Scheme by the Talcher Coalfields Limited;
