## REGISTRATION OF INDIANS IN SOUTH AFRICA

- \*583. SHRI S. PANIGRAHI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether any census is going to be held in South Africa;
- (b) whether Indians residing there have been asked to fill up forms giv ing their dates of birth, citizenship etc.; and
- (c) if so, what are the contents of such forms?

THE **DEPUTY** MINISTER EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI ANIL K. CHANDA): (a) Government is not aware if any census is going to be held but, at present, there is none being taken in South Africa. Non-Europeans, including Asians, who are described in South Africa as "Asiatics" are, however, now being registered under the Population Registration Act (30 of 1950). The purpose of registration is to classify them according to their various racial groups.

## (b) Yes.

(c) The form is a lengthy 8-page document. The details to be filled up includes name, race, date and place of birth, particulars if any of permit, certificate or other document issued by the Immigration Department, nationality, and if a "South African

Citizen" by birth, descent of registration full reasons for being treated as a South African citizen.
