

SHRI S. N. MAZUMDAR: Is the hon. Minister aware that so far as the functions of these committees are concerned, the Government is not clear in its own mind, because in the case of one Ministry, only one meeting of that Committee has been held and v/hen some Members asked for some general information, the Ministry was not very clear as to how they can give the information, as there was no guiding line as to how the Committee should function?

SHRI SATYA NARAYAN SINHA: I have indicated the general principle of the constitution of these consultative committees, but I do not know about the particular case and the particular Ministry about which the hon. Member has mentioned.

SHRI H. C. MATHUR: May I know in what sense these Committees are consultative? Who consults them and in what matters?

SHRI SATYA NARAYAN SINHA: It is mutual consultation. The Ministers consult the Members and the Members also consult the Ministers.

SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA: The hon. Minister said that these Committees have been formed to enable the Members to have a glimpse of the working of the administration. I should have thought that they would be called 'glimpse committees', but anyway, may I know what sort of consultation takes place, what steps the Government take with regard to the views expressed by Members on different subjects there, whether they are given any importance and given any attention or whether these consultative Committees are there just in order to humour the Members of Parliament somehow or other?

SHRI SATYA NARAYAN SINHA: Anything coming from Members of Parliament is naturally given due attention and consideration. It goes without saying.

SHRI H. C. MATHUR: If you look at this statement you will find that some of the Ministries, at least the Commerce and Industry Ministry, have not convened any meeting so far. What is the justification for this?

SHRI SATYA NARAYAN SINHA: I have drawn the attention of all the Ministries to the need for holding meetings frequently and particularly about this Commerce and Industry Ministry, I have drawn the attention of my colleague to this and he is going to call a meeting after the 12th of this month.

DR. P. C. MITRA: What are these institutes and where are they situated?

MR. CHAIRMAN: Please look at the statement.

SHRI SATISH CHANDRA: A long statement has been laid on the Table.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: May I know how many institutions are directly conducted by the Government?

SHRI SATISH CHANDRA: There are several institutions. There is one Central Institute at Nasik which has been established by the Cottage and Village Industries Board. Then there are six regional institutes which have been set up or are in the pro-

cess of being set up. There is also a Central Pottery Institute. The handicrafts Board also runs one or two institutes to train people in different industries.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: Where are these six institutes to be started?

SHRI SATISH CHANDRA: In the different States.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: Yes, but which States and in which places?

SHRI SATISH CHANDRA: One is to be started at Sabarmati and one at Wardha.

PROK. G. RANGA: We have already got one there.

SHRI SATISH CHANDRA: One at Sevapuri, Banaras, and another at Nilokheri. I do not remember the exact locations of other regional institutes.

श्री कृष्णकान्त व्यास : क्या कुटीर उद्योगों के लिए मशीनों निर्माण करने का कोई केंद्र है ? यदि है, तो वहाँ मशीनें तैयार होती हैं ?

श्री सतीश चन्द्र : कुटीर उद्योगों में कोई बड़ी मशीनों की जरूरत नहीं होती। जो छोटे छोटे औजार, इम्प्लीमेंट्स या टूल्स की जरूरत होती है वे बहुत से वर्कशाप्स में तैयार होते हैं। उत्तर देने में कठिनाई यह है कि यह प्रश्न सिर्फ शिक्षण के बारे में है।
