- (a) Rs. 2.24 lakhs.
- (b) (i) 5 per cent. of the steel work completed departmentally. Work in the parcel office has been completed by contractor up to 1st floor.
- (ii) Additions alterations of building will be commenced when the parcel office is shifted.
- (iii) Buildings portion of latrines and urinals completed. Watering arrangements will be completed when the tanks which are on order are received.
- (c) The entire structural work will be done through contractors, except sanitary fittings and fabriction of steel work.
  - (d) Yes, Sir.
- (e) The work was started on 1st February 1955 and is expected to be completed by December 1955.
- (f) The work was stopped because the plans had to be revised. There was also delay on account of nonreceipt of steel.

Shri D. NARAYAN: May I know if there was a proposal to have a central railway station for Agra instead of having so many stations?

SHRI LAL BAHADUR: Agra will always have a number of stations and I think the Raja-ki-Mandi station can be considered as the central railway station of Agra.

SHRI H. P. SAKSENA: What will be estimated cost of construction of these new works?

SHRI LAL BAHADUR: The cost of this Agra Fort Station is perhaps Rs. 2.24 lakhs.

Shri H. P. SAKSENA: One more question, Sir. I do not know whether it arises from this question. Is it a fact that Agra is going to be made the capital of Uttar Pradesh?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: No, Sir. I have not got the whole information here.

SHRI B. C. GHOSE: Has anything been done or is it in the stage of training and acquiring information?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: In some cases we are actually catching fish.

SHRI B. C. GHOSE: Has there been any fish caught in Bengal as a result of this and been brought to the market?

DR. P. S. DESHMUKH: I recently heard a complaint that we have brought too much fish in the Calcutta market.

SHRI B. C. GHOSE: As a result of the schemes with Japanese trawlers or as a result of development schemes under the T. C. M., there are so many fishy schemes that we do not know what the fishes are doing in West Bengal.

Dr. P. S. DESHMUKH: May be due to the combined effect of these schemes.
