DR. R. P. DUBE: Is there any Selection Board to select candidates?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: Yes, the R. T. O. makes the selection along with others.

SHRIMATI VIOLET ALVA: Are they all employed after training?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: They are not employed but they are given certificates that they have undergone this course and they are approved guides and certain scales of fee are prescribed. They have to find their own employment. They can be of use to tourists that come to this country.

SHRIMATI VIOLET ALVA: Is it to encourage private business? Is each tourist guide left to himself after training?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: They are not regularly employed but they can be of service to the tourists that come to this country by guiding them. They need not be regularly employed.

SHRIMATI VIOLET ALVA: Are they registered?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: Yes, they are approved guides.

Dr. RAGHUBIR SINH: Are anv rates fixed for the training to be given?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: Yes.

SHRI JASPAT ROY KAPOOR: view of the fact that Agra is an important tourist centre to which a'most every tourist pays a visit do Government propose to start a training centre at Agra?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: I think the students who partook of the course in Delhi wili be available to serve in Agra

Oral Answers

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: No, Sir. We have recently reduced the scales of charges. Also I may tell the House that this is not a matter of income at all, this is to cover only the rent for the accommodation, and services like water supply and electricity. Government do not propose to make any income out of this at all.

TRAINING IN CIVIL AVIATION

*648. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister for Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether at any Civil Aviation Training Centres in India training is imparted free or at concessional rates or on scholarship basis;
- (b) if so, their number and the places where they are located; and
- (c) the number of persons received training at these centres during each of the last two years?

DEPUTY THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR): (a), (b) and (c). I lay on the Table of the Sabha a statement giving the required information.

STATEMENT

- (a) Training in different aspects of civil aviation is available at the Civil Aviation Training Centre, Allahabad and at the different Flying Clubs, the Gliding Centre, Poona and the Delhi Gliding Club. The training provided is generally at concessional rates. There is also a scheme for the grant of 50 scholarships of Rs. 500 each to encourage flying for 'A' licence at Flying Clubs. Selections for the scholarships are expected to be made short-
- (b) The Civil Aviation Training Centre at Allahabad comprises four schools-The Communications School, The Aircraft Maintenance Engineers School. The Flying School and the Air Traffic Control School. There are at present 11 Flying Clubs, namely, The Delhi Flying Club, Delhi, The Rajasthan Flying Club, Jaipur, the Northern India Flying Club. Jullunder, the Hind Provincial Flying Club, Lucknow (with satellites at Kanpur and Allahabad), the Bihar Flying Club, Patna, the Bengal Flying Club, Barrackpore, the Orissa Flying Bubhaneshwar, the Madras Flying Club, Madras, the Mysore Govt. Flying School, Bangalore, the Bombay Flying Club, Bombay and the Madhya Pradesh Flying Club, Nagpur. Gliding training is available at the Gliding Centre, Poona and at the Delhi Gliding Club, Delhi.
