SHRI K. C. REDDY: As regards cost, have already said that I would require tice to answer that question.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: Is it a fact ir, that till recently penicillin was aported from foreign countries and aly bottling done in India?

Shri K. C. REDDY: No, Sir. There e certain firms already manufacturing penicillin in the country. Also, certain bottling has been going on of imported penicillin.

SHRI KISHEN CHAND: Is it a fact. ir, that eighty per cent. in value, of he raw materials is being imported om foreign countries for the manuacture of penicillin?

SHRI K. C. REDDY: Yes, Sir. I have iven an answer already. The hon. Iember can draw his own inference.

DR. RAGHUBIR SINH: Is it not orrect, Sir, that Corn Steep Liquor is roduced from maize? Do we not roduce maize in India from which we an produce this liquor here?

SHRI K. C. REDDY: To produce it rom Peanut Meal is considered to be heaper.

DR. R. P. DUBE: May I know, Sir. /hat will be the cost of production /hen it is ready, when the peak prouction is reached? The hon. Minister aid that Rs. 34 lakhs will be spent on hat. What will be the cost of producion then?

SHRI K. C. REDDY: We have to arrive at the cost at the time when it s produced. Now, it can only be an estimate and it is not proper to go nto the question now.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Dr. Dube, your ext question.

Use of Indian made Components in Indian Cars

*667. DR. R. P. DUBE: Will the Minister for Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the progress made since 1951 in the use of Indian-made components in ndian cars.

- (b) whether the above progress is measured in terms of number of components or in terms of value thereof in relation to the total cost of the complete car; and
- (c) the year in which 90 per cent, of the total components used in a car are likely to be of Indian origin?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR COM-MERCE AND INDUSTRY: (SHRI N. KANUNGO): (a) The progress achieved in the incorporation of Indian made components in cars approved for manufacture in the country varies from car to car. The indigenous components are reported to form 65 per cent. of the "Hindusthan 14", while those of the Premier Automobiles are 50 per cent. of the "Dodge" truck.

- (b) In terms of the total imported cost of the car.
- (c) It is difficult to forecast the year oy which 90 per cent. manufacture could be achieved, but it should be possible, with the present rate of progress, to attain this target during the second Five Year Plan period in respect of at least some of the approved makes.

DR. R. P. DUBE: May I know, Sir, the price of the parts that are imported? Which are the parts that are imported; and which are being made here?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: As far as the "Hindusthan 14" is concerned, 65 per cent. of the components are made here in value and the balance imported.

DR. R. P. DUBE: Is it in value, this 65 per cent.?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: Yes, Sir.

Shri LALCHAND HIRACHAND DOSHI: Will the hon. Minister be pleased to place on the Table a statement showing the components produced for the different vehicles?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: I will do it at a later stage, Sir.

[RAJYA SABHA]

SHRIMATI VIOLET ALVA: May Ι know, Sir, whether the 7½ per cent. reduction in price of the "Hindusthan" cars, that has been made, is due to this progressive local manufacture of the component parts?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: Possibly.

Dr. R. P. DUBE: May I know, Sir, what parts are imported? Are we importing nuts and bolts or are we importing engines and things that?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: Well, Sir, it is a long list and as I have said, when I place the statement on the Table of the House, at a later stage, the hon. Member will know about it.

SHRI M. M. SUR: May 1 know, Sir, how many of these items are manufactured, such as engine cylinder, olocks. crankshaft, inlet and exhaust valves, plugs, etc.?

Mr. CHAIRMAN: He will place a statement on the Table which will give these details.

DR. R. P. DUBE: With 65 per cent. of the parts made here, may I know, Sir, why the cars are sold 100 per cent, above the prices they are sold elsewhere?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: I cannot say it is 100 per cent, above, but it is settled according to the terms of the Tariff Commission in the country.

DR. SHRIMATI SEETA PARMA-NAND: May I know, Sir, whether these parts are manufactured under the guidance of foreign technicians? And, if so, to what nationality do these technicians belong?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: Foreign technicians are employed in some of the manufacturing concerns, but how many direct them and what their nationality is, I can answer only on notice.

SHRI M. GOVINDA REDDY: the Tariff Commission taken into consideration the fact that these manufacturing concerns have also distributing agencies of their own and they charge a heavy commission for the distribut ing agency and that is the reason fo the high price of the cars?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: The Tari Commission have taken all factors int consideration

SHRI K. S. HEGDE: Is it a fact, Si that nowadays there is a progressiv deterioration in the quality of th cars?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: That is no correct, Sir.

Dr. D. H. VARIAVA: May I ask Sir, if foreign manufacturers have als reduced their price by 7½ per cent. fo their cars?

SHRI N. KANUNGO: Imports foreign cars are prohibited.

OFFICERS EMPLOYED IN THE INTEGRATEI PUBLICITY PROGRAMME

*668. DR. R. P. DUBE: Will th. Minister for Iformation and Broad-CASTING be pleased to state the numbe of Officers at present engaged in the Integrated Publicity Programme for the Five Year Plan?

THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETA RY TO THE MINISTER FOR INFORMA TION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI G RAJAGOPALAN): A Statement is laid or the Table of the House. [See Appendix IX, Annexure No. 140.]

DR. R. P. DUBE: May I know, Sir whether the class I, II and III officers were first recruited and then appeared before the U.P.S.C.?

SHRI G. RAJAGOPALAN: Class I class II and class II (non gazetted) are recruited, some through the U.P.S.C and some people are recruited directly and then approved by the U.P.S.C.

DR. R. P. DUBE: Are they being given any training, because this relates to a particular thing, i.e., Integrated Publicity Programme for the Five Year
