DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Yes, Sir. The Government of India are giving grants to State Governments to implement the recommendations of the Secondary Education Commission.

DR. SHRIMATI SEETA PARMA-NAND: May I know, Sir, which are the State Governments who have set up their own Secondary Education Commissions?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: As far as the Government of India are aware, the following State Governments have set up their own Commissions: Uttar Pradesh; Madhya Pradesh; Bombay; Mysore and more recently West Bengal.
