River? There have been complaints from the public about this.

Shri D. P. KARMARKAR: I know this question arises in the case of every factory. I am not particularly informed about this Madhya Bharat factory but proper care is taken to see that such pollution does not affect the region.

Shri GOPIKRISHNA VIJAIVAR-GIYA: Will the Government now take care to see that something is done about the Chambal river?

Shri D. P. KARMARKAR: We have always taken care to do the best in such matters.

- SHRI J. S. L. HATHI: The former States had started but they have been included in the Plan in 1951 and they were included later on and actually the late site was abandoned and the recent work was started only in 1953.
