WAGONS AND COACHES RECEIVED BY THE RAILWAYS

\*331. Dr. RAGHUBIR SINH: Will the Minister for RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of new railway wagons and coaches received by the Indian Railways during August, 1954;
- (b) how many of these were received from abroad and from which countries; and
- (c) how these receipts compare with those of the previous or later month?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR RAILWAYS AND TRANSPORT (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): (a), (b) and (c). A statement giving the detailed information is laid on the Table of the House. [See Appendix VIII, Annexure No. 86.]

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: If he wants the names of the firms which supply these things, I can give the
