Government who on the date of the constitution of the Indian Administrative Service Cadre in that State, were holding posts to be included thereafter in that Cadre or other equivalent posts were eligible for appointment to the Indian Administrative Service. Such officers were considered in the first instance by the State Government and then interviewed by the Special Recruitment Board.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR FINANCE (SHRI A. C. GUHA): (a) Total number of cases where loan was actually advanced and remained outstanding with the Rehabilitation Financ* Administration up to the end of 1953 was 9,670. Out of this, instalments fell due for repayment in 5,766 cases and rebate was allowed to about 1,000 of these loanees. The percentage thus works out to about 17.

- (b) The actual effect of the reduction in the rate of interest on the recovery position cannot be assessed at this stage. Most of the loanees from West Pakistan having verified claims are in fact holding back the payment following the decision of the Administration to postpone coercive measures for recovery of loans up to 1/10th ot the assessed claims of such borrow-
