श्री कन्हेयालाल डी० वैद्य: क्या मंत्री महोदय बतलाने की कृपा करेगे कि यह स्पेशल कहां से रवाना होकर कहां जा रही थी ? इस द्घंटना से सम्बन्धित कोई और कारण है, क्या इस विषय में भी जांच की गई?

श्री लाल बहाद्र : कहां जा रही थी इसके बतलाने की जरूरत नहीं मालम होती, कोई और दूसरा कारण इसके पीछे नहीं मालूम होता।

श्री कृष्णकांत व्यास : वया मृत व्यक्तियों के परिवार वालों को कोई मुआविजा दिया जायगा ।

श्री लाल बहादुर: जी हां, इस पर ग़ौर किया जा रहा है। लेकिन जिन को चोट लगी है या मरे हैं, वे ज्यादातर फौज के आदमी हैं। फौज के सिपाहियों को मुआ-विजा टिफेंस डिपार्टमेंट से दिया जाता है। इस लिए अगर वहां से नहीं दिया जायगा, तब हम विचार करेंगे अगर वहां से दिया जायगा तो हम विचार करने की जरूरत नहीं होगी।

FEEDER SERVICES BETWEEN BOMBAY, INDORE AND GWALIOR

(a) whether it is a fact that the Indian Airlines Corporation have decided to operate a feeder service between Bombay, Indore and Gwalior; and

(b) if so, when the operation of this service will commence?

SHRI T. S. PATTABIRAMAN: (Put the question in Tamil and then translated it into English). I could not understand the answer. My question was whether similar services will be operated between Madura and Trichinopoly and Salem and Madras.

SHRI RAJ BAHADUR: We have three proposals on hand. One is Delhi-Agra - Gwalior - Bhopal - Indore-Aurangabad-Bombay, which should have been known to the hon. Member. The second is in regard to Madras-Trichinopoly, Madura, Trivandrum-Cochin-Coimbatore-Bangalore-Madras the third is Delhi-Bikaner-Jodhpur-Ahmedabad-Rajkot.

Dr. RAGHUBIR SINH: planes are going to be run on these?

SHRI RAJ BAHADUR: To begin with the proposal is to put dakotas on these three lines and later on when we get Herons, we might utilize some of them.

Dr. D. H. VARIAVA: Will he let me know whether there is any scheme to connect Rajkot with Jamnagar which is not being connected by plane services?

REPRESENTATION FOR TAKING OVER OF B, P. RAILWAY

- \*501. SHRI B. C. GHOSE: Will the Minister for RAILWAYS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have received any representations requesting them to take over the B. P. Railway in the district of Hooghly in West Bengal;
- (b) if so, what action Government have taken or propose to take in the matter:
- (c) whether the B. P. Railway has recently been inspected by the Railway authorities; and
- (d) if the answer to part (c) above be in the affirmative, the nature of the report submitted after such inspection?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR RAILWAYS AND TRANSPORT (SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Government are of the view that the proposal for the acquisition

of the Railway by Government is not justified.

(c) and (d). The Railway was inspected by the Government Inspector of Railways in March 1954. His report shows that even though no works are required to be carried out in the interest of public safety, the overall condition of the Railway is far from satisfactory owing to lack of funds.

Shri B. C. GHOSE: Is the Government considering any proposal to offer any financial assistance to this Railway?

Shri O. V. ALAGESAN: A committee presided over by the Chief Minister of West Bengal went into this question and on their recommendation a loan of Rs. 1.5 lakhs was advanced to the West Bengal Government.

SHRI B. C. GHOSE: When was it? Was it some time ago?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: Yes.

SHRI B. C. GHOSE: Is there any other proposal to advance any other money to this Railway?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: None, Sir.

Shri B. C. GHOSE: But I saw the hon. Railway Minister also standing.

SHRI LAL BAHADUR: One of the representatives of this Committee met me a few days ago and he has made a representation for giving the company further financial assistance. I have told him that we will consider that. But we are at present awaiting the report of the General Manager.

Shri B. C. GHOSE: Has the hon. Minister received any representation from the affected interests in the locality to the effect that no financial assistance should be given to this company as the management has not proved satisfactory and therefore, other alternative proposals should be considered?
