DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The Secondary Education Commission has made certain recommendations regarding secondary education, and the report of the Commission is before all the various State Governments.

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: As far as I know, Prof. Kabir has written one on School Discipline.

SHRI S. MAHANTY: I want to know how many he has written.

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: I shall have to check up the list, but that is the only one which occurs to me at the present moment.

SHRI B. GUPTA: May I know for how long he has been out of touch with this matter?
