MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: He has already said that in his reply.

SHRI P. C. BHANJ DEO: May I know, Sir, whether the fares for third class passengers charged in Russia in Russian Railways are relatively much higher than the charges here?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: They seem to be much higher and on the basis of the exchange rate they seem to be equivalent to our second class fare.

SHRI P. C. BHANJ DEO: Are those rates going to be made applicable to this country?

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Order, order.

DR. W. S. BARLINGAY: Is it not a fact, Sir, that decisions have already been taken by the Government on the recommendations made?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: On the first three we have taken a decision and orders to Railway Administrations are under issue. They relate to provision of common exits, allowing third class passengers to use the dining cars and provision of two sets of information services.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: Have the Government fixed up the excess that is to be charged for sleeping berths?

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: All that is under consideration.

DR. R. P. DUBE: The Minister was pleased to say that the rates in Russia were higher. But what were the facilities available? Were they the same as we have here?

MR. DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: It is a matter of opinion.

SHRI O. V. ALAGESAN: Nine tenders were received.
