

PREVALENCE OF POLIOMYELITIS IN BOMBAY

71. SHRI S. N. MAZUMDAR: Will the Minister for HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the prevalence of Poliomyelitis in Bombay in an epidemic form; and

(b) whether Government have taken any steps to help the Government of Bombay in combating the disease?

THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH (RAJKUMARI AMRIT KAUR): (a) The Government of India have been informed of an increase in the incidence of Poliomyelitis in sporadic form in Bombay, particularly in Bombay city.

(b) Yes. An 'iron lung' has been loaned to the Bombay Municipal Corporation for use at their Infectious Diseases Hospital.

REVISION OF THE PAY SCALES OF MINISTERIAL STAFF ON N.E. RAILWAY
