

Deemed universities

*368. SHRI LEKHRAJ BACHANI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of deemed universities sanctioned in the country, State wise;
- (b) whether such universities can open and start any college in other States; and
- (c) whether Government are aware that unrecognised colleges in various faculties are opened in various States without affiliations to any university or sanction of the the concerned State Government?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) A state-wise of 98 institutions, declared as Deemed to be University by notification of the Central Government under Section 3 of the Unviersity Grants Commission (UGC), Act, 1956, is annexed as Statement. (*See below*)

(b) Institutions, declared as 'deemed to be unviersity' can not open or start colleges, however, UGC Guidelines on deemed to be universities provide for setting up of constituent units within or outside the institutions' campus, after seeking requisite approvals.

(c) No Sir. Colleges are affiliated to State Universities under the provisions of the Acts of the respective State Legislatures.
