THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI J. S. L. HATHI):

(a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Central assistance is given only for schemes included in the Plan.

FINANCIAL RESOURCES OF THE STATES

431. DR. R. P. DUBE: Will the Minister for PLANNING be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the States which have not so far raised the requisite finances from their own resources to the extent estimated in the Five Year Plan; and

(b) the names of the States which have raised more than the requisite finances?

MANUFACTURE OF MOTOR CYCLES

(b) whether any target has been fixed in the Five Year Plan for the manufacture of motor-cycles; if so, what is; the target; and

(c) the annual requirements of motor cycles in the country?

THE MINISTER FOR COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI T. T. KRISHNA-MACHARI): (a) No, Sir. However, a

firm in Madras have been granted a licence under the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951, for setting up a factory for the manufacture of motor-cycles.

(c) The annual demand is estimated at 6,000.

(d) where the last annual meeting of the Organisation was held; and

(e) when and in which country its meeting is proposed to be held?
