*706. PROF. R. D. SINHA DINKAR: Will the Minister for EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) the names of the areas where the Scheme of Intensive Education Development has been introduced;

(b) the programmes included in the Scheme; and

(c) the results so far achieved?

THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY TO THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) A statement is laid on the Table of the House. [See Appendix VII, Annexure No. 313]

(b) The institutions and schemes proposed to be established or developed are: —

(i) (a) A post-graduate training college for the staff of basic training colleges and the administrative personnel.

(b) A full fledged basic school for practice and administration.

(ii) (a) A basic training college for primary school teachers.

(b) Two junior basic schools-for practice and demonstration.

(iii) Five well planned community centres.

(iv) An integrated library service for the area.

(v) \ Janata college in the area for training village leaders.

(vi) A scheme of grants for the improvement of primary and basic schools in the selected area from the point of view of teachers, equipment, supervision, etc.

(c) Progress reports from the States* are awaited.

AUCTION OF TANK PLATES IN E. S. D., PANAGAR

*707. SHRI B. GUPTA: Will the Minister for DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether certain tank plates from the Engineering Stores Depot, Panagar were sold by auction in the month of March this year; and

(b) if so, whether any complaints have been made by certain employees of that Depot in regard to the delivery of the auctioned materials?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR DEFENCE (SARDAR S. S. MAJITHIA): (a) Yes. Some scrap steel including tank plates estimated to be 70 tons was disposed of by auction on 22nd February 1954.

(b) No complaint was made by the employees of the Depot but the Bengal and Assam Workers Union, which is neither a registered nor a recognised body, did complain that the tonnage of scrap auctioned was in excess of 70 tons and they wanted the purchaser to be stopped from collecting it.

SHRI B. GUPTA: May I know what steps were taken with regard to the complaints that were made?

SARDAR S. S. MAJITHIA: The Government has ordered an enquiry into it and that is being looked into.
