ANTI-BIOTICS

244. Lt.-Col. J. S. MANN: Will the Minister for Commerce and Industry be pleased to state whether anti-biotic drugs are produced in India; if so, whether the production is enough to meet the requirements in the country?

THE MINISTER FOR COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI'T. T. KRISHNA-MACHARI): Aureomycin is the only antibiotic drug which is being partly manufactured in the country, and its production is considered sufficient to meet the country's present requirements. Other antibiotics such as penicillin, streptomycine, chloram-phenical, terramycene, etc., are now wholly imported.
