SHRI S. N. MAZUMDAR: When is the final report expected?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: The final report or the interim report?

SHRI S. N. MAZUMDAR: The final report of this committee. So long we have discussed about the interim report.

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: I have no idea as to the probable date when the Committee will submit its report to the Government of Bihar.

GANDHI MEMORIAL DESIGN COMMITTEE

*60. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister for Works, Housing and Supply be pleased to state:

(a) the progress so far made by the Gandhi Memorial Design Committee;

(b) when this Committee was constituted; and

(c) whether any advice has been sought by the Committee from any foreign experts on designs?

THE MINISTER FOR WORKS, HOUS-ING AND SUPPLY (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): (a) The Committee have approved the design for the memorial.

(b) On the 1st May 1950.

(c) While no such advice has been specifically sought, foreign experts have offered suggestions in this behalf, from time to time.

PROF. G. RANGA: In view of the fact that it has taken three years for this Committee to finalise the plan for the design, may I know how much time Government propose to take in order to execute the work?

SARDAR SWARAN SINGH: Sir, this Committee was advisory in character and, after Government have approved of the suggestions made by the Committee, it will take about a year and a half for completing the Samadhi.

SARDAR SWARAN SINGH: Sir, a large number of designs were received; ultimately, two were selected and models were prepared which were inspected by the public, by Ministers and other persons.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: Who are the Members of the Committee?

SARDAR SWARAN SINGH: Shri Devadas Gandhi: Kaka Kalelkar; Shri Rathindranath Tagore of Shantiniketan; Shri V. P. Karmarkar, Sculptor, Bombay; the Chief Engineer, C.P.W.D.; the Senior Architect, C.P.W.D.; and myself.

SHRI D. NARAYAN: How much time will the construction take?

SARDAR SWARAN SINGH: I have already replied to that question.

MR. CHAIRMAN: He said, " $1\frac{1}{2}$ years after the approval of the design".

(b) Subsistence allowance—Rs.4,580 at the rate of Rs. 10 per day per expert.

Travelling allowance-Rs 78.

SHRI S. MAHANTY: Sir, may I know if these experts were requisitioned under the Colombo Plan or under the Technical Co-operation Administration?

SHRI J. S. L. HATHI: They were requisitioned under the Colombo Plan.
